The clinic sponsors adult workshops for handwriting improvement and has developed corporate training inservices. She is an experienced speaker, and her workshops are informative and FUN! Course Description:

Handwriting can be slow and tedious in today's world of technology. Most adults have a "need for speed" of handwriting, especially in the health care setting. Legibility plays an important factor in human errors in medicine. The healthcare or corporate professional has knowledge and expertise that must be conveyed to others, often through handwritten work. One does not have to be taken back to First Grade with repetitive drills for handwriting, in order to improve handwriting. There are errors of handwriting that occur as handwriting matures and speed becomes an issue. Identifying common patterns and employing quick remedial techniques can quickly make handwriting more legible. This course teaches quick techniques for the busy professional to remediate handwriting. This course is hands on, fun, and not boring! It is also very important – because if you value what you do, and want others to value your expertise, it is important that they be able to read your handwriting!

Prices:

Individual sessions are \$100 per hour, plus a \$15 workbook fee

Workshops at the clinic in Plano, are \$400 for the 2 our class, plus a \$15 workbook fee per person. Can accommodate up to 8 adults.
